The exhibition will start at 4:00 p.m. Skaters will have a 6 min warm up. Depending on the duration of the show, we may have an ice cut after the first half followed by a 6 min warm up for the skaters performing in the second half.

Register with the monitors: The sign-up sheet is with the ice monitors. Home club members, associate members, coaches and Learn to Skate skaters are welcome to participate. Our goal is to have as many skaters as possible perform in the show. You can choose to skate a solo, duo, trio or a larger group number. You will be responsible for your costume, choreography, music and practices for your solos and group numbers.

Deadline to Register: Friday April 21, 2023

Music: any music of your choice or skate your current short program or dance/exhibition program

Duration of music will be according to your **Freeskate level** as follows:

- Seniors and Juniors: 2min 50 sec (max)
- Juveniles, Intermediates and Novices: 2 min 30 sec (max)
- Open Juv, Adult Silver and Adult Gold: 2min 10 sec (max)
- Preliminary to Beginner: 1min 40 sec (max)
- Pre- Free Skate to Freeskate 6: 1 min 20 sec (max)
- Snowplow to Basic 6: 1min 10 sec (max)

Solos: Skaters can only sign up for one solo number. Seniors in High School will have priority. Skaters are allowed to be in a solo and also be in 1 or more group numbers.

Groups: We will try to accommodate group numbers as time permits after all the solos are scheduled. Group numbers will be added on a first come first serve basis. Group of skaters who do not have a solo will have priority over groups who already have solos.

On the sign-up sheet please write your name, Freeskate level, music and duration of your program.

The **cost is \$25.00/number.** This is an increase of \$5.00 to help us pay the photographer for his work and cover flowers for seniors, gift card for the announcer and the music technician. If there is any money left, we will use it to help pay for food. The \$20.00 is to pay for renting the ice (\$240.00/hour)
